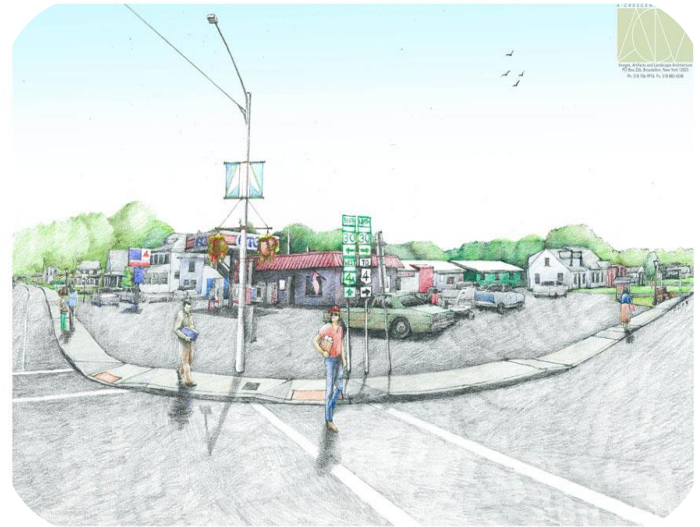


SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

This sidewalk project will connect important areas of the Town, including Castleton State College and the Four Corners area, and provide safe passage for pedestrians. The existing walkways are a combination of gravel paths, deteriorating pavement and grass. The completed project will encourage pedestrian use and increase safety.

Dufresne Group completed design and permitting for the project for construction in 2014. This project consists of approximately 2,950 linear feet of new concrete sidewalk and granite curb on South Street, VT Route 30 and VT Route 4.

This project will include access modifications based on VTrans standard details to increase safety and limit access onto State highways. On Route 30, a new sidewalk will provide a pedestrian corridor between VT Route 4A and the Castleton Family Health Center.

KEY FEATURES:

- Funded by VTrans local Transportation Facilities (LTF) Program.
- Provide pedestrian access on VT Route 30 and resolved unsafe conditions at the school bus stop.
- Enhanced aesthetics of heavily trafficked corridors.
- Completed the second phase of downtown streetscapes improvement project.
