KEY FEATURES

- Challenging construction conditions including a heavily congested site.
- Replacement of 110 year old water main.
- Successful coordination with three municipal departments.



After

The Town of Manchester's Highway, Sewer and Water Departments worked together to upgrade drainage, sewer, the water system and reshape the road along a busy commercial and residential street. The project included 1,800 lf of road reconstruction, 1,000 lf of gravity sewer, 1,200 lf of water main and 500 lf of new granite curb. The project addresses deficiencies identified in the Manchester Water System Master Plan and improves fire flow protection.
