KEY FEATURES

- Completed design according to VTrans Standards under direction of a Municipal Project Manager.
- Reuse of granite plinth stonework
- Coordination with existing storm drain facilities
- Coordination with above ground power utilities
- Resetting of about 650 feet of granite curbing along the sidewalk
- Reconstruction of existing retaining wall and drainage system
- Coordination with Route 302 curvature.

The Groton Village Pedestrian Walkway project included design of sidewalk rehabilitation along US Route 302, within Groton Village Limits as part of a Village Rehabilitation Project.

DG understood that the goal of the Groton Village Revitalization Project was to develop plans for sidewalk rehabilitation that also included landscaping, street lighting and traffic calming.

Project challenges included the need to accommodate existing on-street parking patterns, particularly at the Post Office. The project design was substantially completed; however, requirements for utility pole relocation have delayed construction.
