

HARTLAND SIDEWALK PROJECT

HARTLAND, VERMONT



The Hartland Sidewalk project established a new sidewalk to provide safety for pedestrians traveling along busy Route 5, which experiences heavy truck traffic. The project was funded under the VTrans Enhancement Grant Program.

The project original design was for 4,000 lf of concrete sidewalk with granite curb, drainage improvements and a retaining wall. The project scope was reduced due to funding constraints but the original goal to provide a safe path for school children was achieved.

Storm drain system modifications including rehabilitating existing catch basins and installing new catch basins, curb inlets and storm drain pipes.

KEY FEATURES

- State right-of-way survey and deed research to support Town easement negotiations.
- Segmental retaining wall to avoid encroaching on private property.
- Permitting assistance including:
 - ⇒ VTrans Highway Access Permit
 - ⇒ Categorical Exclusion
 - ⇒ VTrans ROW Clearance
- Construction services including Resident Project Representation.
