

WEIDMANN ELECTRICAL TECHNOLOGIES BOARDMILL #2 EXPANSION PERMIT ASSISTANCE ST. JOHNSBURY, VERMONT

When officials at Weidmann Electrical Technologies, Inc. (Weidmann) became aware that the financing of a \$40M expansion project at the St. Johnsbury Weidmann Electrical Technologies plant were contingent on obtaining permits before January 1, 2011, they contacted Dufresne Group (DG) for assistance.

DG worked with Weidmann Project Managers, attorneys from Downs, Rachlin and Martin, the building and manufacturing engineers, Hill Engineers, Architects and Planners, Inc. and permit officials to submit and obtain State and local permits in a matter of weeks.

Dufresne Group was contacted on October 11, 2010 and DG provided a draft Act 250 permit application for the remainder of the project team's review on October 14, 2010. DG prepared and assisted with obtaining all associated permits within 9 weeks, including design, submittal, review and public notice periods.

The expansion began construction in the summer of 2011, and will allow Weidmann to secure approximately 280 jobs in the Northeast Kingdom for decades.
